

ABS plastic wing 2pcs. M6x15 bolts

The product's material, made of **ABS** plastic with acrylic exterior layer, can be placed on your bike without requiring painting but if you want it painted, all paint companies have equivalent machinery at their disposal. If you want to paint it yourself, you should contact them to inform you on what you will need and how to do it.



### Placement

### OUR COMPANY SUGGESTS THE INSTALLATION BE CARRIED OUT AT A WORKSHOP OR BY QUALIFIED STAFF

- Remove the chain guard.
- Clean well the area around the swing arm
- Remove the base that holds the rear brake tube (Photo No 1).
- Remove the protective film of the hugger.
- Put the hugger in position (insert the right side of the wing underneath the brake tube)
- Bolt on the right side of the hugger the base of the rear brake tube (while holding it together with the wing) and the left one at the old location of the chain guard.
- Before you tighten the screws make sure that you've placed the hugger in the correct position.
