MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS

The product's material, made of ABS plastic with acrylic exterior layer, can be placed on your bike without requiring painting but if you want it painted, all paint companies have equivalent machinery at their disposal. If you want to paint it yourself, you should contact them to inform you on what you will need and how to do it.





<u>Placement</u> <u>OUR COMPANY SUGGESTS THE INSTALLATION BE CARRIED OUT AT A WORKSHOP OR BY QUALIFIED STAFF</u>

- Remove the chain guard.
- Clean well the area around the swing arm (Photo No 1).
- Remove the base that holds the rear brake tube.
- Put the clips nuts on the brackets and stick on them the foam tape pieces.
- Slide the brackets beneath the swing arm so that you attach them on the wing and then place the screws (Photo No 2).
- On the right side, reposition the base of the brake tube and hold them altogether with the bolt (above the wing).
- Before you tighten the screws make sure that you've placed the hugger in the correct position (wing centered on the wheel).
