CONTENTS

The product's material, made of **ABS** plastic with acrylic exterior layer, can be placed on your bike without requiring painting but if you want it painted, all paint companies have equivalent machinery at their disposal. If you want to paint it yourself, you should contact them to inform you on what you will need and how to do it.





<u>Placement</u> <u>OUR COMPANY SUGGESTS THE INSTALLATION BE CARRIED OUT AT A WORKSHOP OR BY QUALIFIED STAFF</u>

- Clean well the area around the swing arm.
- Remove the front bolt from the chain guard.
- Put the clips on the support bracket and stich the adhesive foam tape on the inner side of the bracket so as to avoid scratching the swing arm.
- Place the two Velcro pieces on the inner side of the rear hugger and at the front corners.
- Place the bracket on the inner side of the swing arm so as to make a perfect fit.
- Place the hugger in position (Photos No 1& 2), and screw on the bolt of the chain guard (left).
- Bolt on the right side of the hugger with the bracket. By moving the bracket you can adjust the distance between the rear hugger and the
 wheel.
- Push the front side of the hugger so that the Velcro sticks well enough.
